- Principals must submit their job share paperwork to Human Resources by January 31, 2017. We recommend you **submit your job share requests NO LATER than January 27, 2017.**
- **Current Job Share Teachers**: If you want to continue your job share assignment next year, you must submit another joint request and secure your principal's approval. (CFT CBA p. 45, line 15-16)
