Transfer Rounds - The 2018 Teacher Transfer Round schedule has been amended. Julia Indelacio emailed the amended schedule to all certificated personnel on January 30, 2017.

What if I am Surplussed? - If you receive a surplus notice, you are not fired, you are under contract. Look at it as an opportunity to experience different schools and staffs in the district early in your career. Apply in the transfer rounds for every position you are qualified for.

District Leader Teacher Position Postings - Do you have CPS Lead Teacher Credentials and are interested in serving in a leadership role at the district level? Several district lead teacher positions are available! (Teachers cannot serve in two lead teacher positions at the same time.) Look for an announcement to come out early next week. Under our new collective bargaining agreement, current teachers are welcome to participate in the CPS Job Fair at Woodward Career Technical High School on February 10. Come to the Job Fair to network, share your freshly polished resume, and give your transfer application a boost.

2017 W2's - The Treasurer's Office has informed us that 2017 W2's will be mailed and available for print on employee online. January 31, 2018 is the deadline for completion.

Overload payments - Overload amounts are posted in the Board Minutes usually on the Tuesday prior to the payment. Please check MyCPS for the Superintendents Recommendations and Treasurer's Report to verify that your overload has been approved and if the amount is correct.

Pay Schedules & Board Procedure - There is a procedure that must be followed when certificated personnel are being paid outside of their contract. First a personnel requisition must be submitted to Human Resources and approved. Once approved by HR and Treasurer's Office, names are submitted to be approved by the Board of Education. Once approved via BOE, payment should be expected on the next paycheck. If you are expecting any extended pay, please check the board minutes regularly.
