Welcome to March in Cincinnati, where you can actually see all four seasons in one day! Here are your updates for this week:

**Teacher Transfer Rounds** - **Transfer Round One Vacancies will be posted on Frontline from 2/19 - 2/22.** Interview teams should interview from 2/25 –
3/6. Another round of vacancies will be posted after the first round, including vacancies created as successful applicants receive new positions. Continue to monitor for additional vacancies if Round 2 if you are not selected in Round 1.

Who Gets a Position? Our contract provides that "teacher requests for transfer will be honored if positions are available and the teacher is qualified for a particular vacancy." But if there are more than one "qualified" internal candidate, then the Interview Panel can look at "training, experience, and individual qualifications" in deciding which candidate to select. If those factors are "substantially equal," then seniority controls.

**REMEMBER:** New hires cannot be considered until after the transfer rounds are completed and all qualified internal candidates are considered. "Qualification" means certification/license for the posted position. If there is a qualified internal candidate, then the interview panel should select that candidate without interviewing external candidates. If there are no qualified internal candidates in the first round, then the Panel can consider "new hires."

**CPS Job Fair, Saturday March 2.** Looking for another opportunity to market yourself and boost your prospects to transfer? Current teachers are welcome to participate in the CPS Job Fair at Woodward High School on March 2. This is a good opportunity for current teachers to meet screening panels from other schools and learn about their staffing needs and programs. Come to the Job Fair to network, share your freshly polished resume, and give your transfer application a boost.

**2019 Navia deposits** – An email from Keith Grace, Benefits Manager went out to all Wellness Champion's today. The message was also posted in the Wellness Portal. If your Wellness Champion did not forward the information to you, please read below:

I know that many employees who participate in the CPS Wellness program and have earned money through the CPS Wellness Works program, expected to have that money loaded onto their Navia Card by now. As a Wellness Champion they may approach you to ask when their money will be available. In case you are approached, I wanted to let you know where the process currently stands.

Due to CPS offering a Health Savings Account along with Wellness Plan money (technically a Health Reimbursement Account), we have to observe additional Federal guidelines. We are working with Navia, and General Counsel to reconcile the accounts and ensure that they are compliant with Federal guidelines. This has been ongoing, and we hope to have everything completed by the end of the day so that the monies are available by Monday. If for some reason this is not the case, we will let you know.
