IEP Completion Log - On April 26, Certificated Personnel sent out an email regarding the IEP Extended Hours form:

Attention all Intervention Specialists!

It has come to our attention that additional clarification was needed for the IEP Extended-Hours form. Therefore, the submission timeline has been extended. The collective bargaining agreement provides compensation in acknowledgment of the significant amount of time that is required of Intervention Specialists completing more than six IEPs in a school year. Intervention Specialists in this situation will receive 14 hours of pay at the extended time daily rate.

There are situations which require teachers to write IEPs in quantities beyond their caseload limit. For example, when there is a lot of student transition from building-to-building,

teachers may end up writing IEPs for students who then transfer out of the building. These individuals are eligible to receive 21 hours of compensation at the extended time rate instead of 14 hours. In no way does this addition legitimize Intervention Specialists serving students in quantities beyond their caseload limits at one given time. Please carefully follow the instructions on the form and submit it to your principal by May 1st. We recommend that you sign the form, scan it and email it to your principal, so that you have receipt of submitting it. Thanks for all that you do for our students!
