## This Labor Day Weekend is brought to you by the American Labor Movement.

The first Labor Day holiday was celebrated on Tuesday, September 5, 1882, in New York City, in accordance with the plans of the Central Labor Union. The Central Labor Union held its second Labor Day holiday just a year later, on September 5, 1883.

In 1884 the first Monday in September was selected as the holiday, as originally proposed, and the Central Labor Union urged similar organizations in other cities to follow the example of New York and celebrate a "workingmen's holiday" on that date. The idea spread with the growth of labor organizations, and in 1885 Labor Day was celebrated in many industrial centers of the country.

**Check your Pay Stub and Employee Information**– Make sure you log into **Employee Online** and verify the following:

- Your base salary is correct. You can compare it to the CFT Salary Schedule found here or the CFOP Salary Schedule found in the rear of the CFOP CBA here.
   Note: Certificated staff, in the Earnings Section of your pay stub, times your biweekly salary by 26 and it should equal your step on the CFT Salary schedule.
- You are accruing the correct amount of sick leave and/or annual leave (for CFOP personnel).
- CFOP members please verify that you are receiving the correct longevity stipends, if you are entitled to one.
- Sr. Support Elementary Specialists, please verify that you are receiving a stipend for either Records or Cashier. You can only receive one or the other. No Sr.

- Support Elementary Specialist should be receiving both stipends. High School Support do not receive these stipends.
- If applicable, please verify that the amount you have designated to be deducted for a TSA is correct.
- Your health care and dental deductions should be the same on every paycheck
- Most importantly, verify that you are a union member. This deduction will appear in the after-tax deductions section in the bottom right of the page.

Employee Online is also where you should make any applicable address/phone number changes or add your emergency contacts. If you have changed your phone number, it is important that you update it. Payroll has tried to contact people to notify them of pay issues only to find that the number is disconnected or changed. Any forms you may need to access are also available on EEO. You can track your "leaves" used and earned in EEO as well as your Direct Deposit and tax information.

Please make it a habit to check your stub every pay week as many of us are aware, random payroll problems have occurred and not caught until it is too late.

HINT: If your check is more than you expect, there is probably a problem. Contact payroll immediately. Don't spend the money until you have verified that it is correct.
