**Arbitration Victory for CFT** - The new school year started with an arbitration victory for CFT and a veteran teacher who had been denied the right to transfer to Walnut Hills High School. Our member had an unblemished record, earned "accomplished" ratings and recently qualified for lead teacher status. He had more than 20 years of experience with CPS. But when he applied for a posted vacancy, he was rejected as not "qualified" in the eyes of the decision makers. Ultimately, the position was filled by a "new hire" with much less experience.

CFT filed a grievance and went to arbitration in the first week of the new school year. A quick and favorable decision allowed the grievant to begin working at Walnut after Labor Day.

The key language of our contract is at p. 41, Section 250-2- a, which provides that "Teacher requests for transfer will be honored if positions are available and the teacher is qualified for a particular vacancy". Our view, which seems to have been accepted by the arbitrator, is that a teacher is "qualified" for a posting if he or she has the license or certification required to fill the position. "New hires" should not be interviewed if there are such qualified internal applicants.

CFT will be working with our building representatives and school interview teams to make sure the contract is followed in the future. Qualified CFT members should receive the first chance to receive vacancies at other CPS schools.
